Brief description of the project

The overall objective of the project “Facilitating integration of ethnic minorities into the labour market through enhancement of their employment potentials” is to facilitate the process of integration of young people from ethnic minorities in Macedonia and to increase their competitiveness in the labour market. This project also aims to increase the employability and self-employment skills to minority young people through flexibly-structured capacity building programs based on individual skill-level assessments, to help in the creation of new businesses set up by young people from minority ethnic groups and to create a capacity building taskforce for continuous support for minority young people regarding their professional development.

Target groups of the project are: young people from the ethnic minorities in Macedonia, potential employers, and relevant institutions and organizations that support women and minorities.

Project activities will result in numerous beneficial opportunities for young people from ethnic minority groups:

- career counseling
- adapted trainings and online trainings for employment and self-employment
- creative workshops for women
- trainings for civil society organizations to conduct online trainings
- provide internships in more companies
- business plan competition and financial assistance from 3000 euro for the 5 best business ideas

The project will last from December 2015 to August 2017.
